The White Earth Reservation Tribal Council is currently seeking a qualified applicant who will be responsible for providing mental health services to American Indian Children, and families who reside on or near the White Earth Reservation. This position will work alongside the First Thunder Being House Program Manager in overseeing the supervision of mental health which can include but is not limited to case formulation and consultations, program development, and maintaining cooperative working relations with partners.

- Provides comprehensive individual and family based therapeutic services for youth and their families to improve client's wellbeing.
- Coordinates prevention/treatment services provided by Mental Health staff.
- Under the supervision and support of the Mental Health Manager, may execute administrative responsibilities to implement the mental health services provided at the First Thunder Being House and oversee the provision of mental health services provided to the program.
- Performs other duties and responsibilities as required or assigned.
