The White Earth Reservation Tribal Council is seeking a qualified candidate who is responsible to oversee the delivery of outpatient treatment services provided by Urban Medical assistant therapy abuse programming for youth and adults. Provides umbrella clinical treatment directions of SUD treatment programs.

- Provides clinical supervision to ADC, LADC, counselor aides and entry level counselors.
- Assists in the overall administration and supervision of programs delivering substance abuse services.
- Oversees CARF or other Accreditation Standards.
- Oversight of SUD policies and procedures.
- Oversight of SUD program EAC and Ethics Board reports.
- Assists in curriculum development and implementation.
- Evaluation of quality assurance across SUD Programs
- Responsible for SUD related forms on electronic health records
- Responsible to professionally represent UMAT on a daily basis, which includes professional level attitude, communication attributes.

Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

- Knowledge of local health, behavioral health, and human services programs.
- Knowledge of laws, rules, regulations including Health Insurance Portability Accountability act (HIPPA), government regulations, federal, state and agency rules.
- Knowledge of principles and methods for teaching and instruction for individuals and groups, and the measurement of training effects.
- Ability to effectively communicate with Urban Treatment Director in a cultural, Anishinaabe way.
- Knowledge of White Earth Youth Residential Standards of Care and White Earth Substance Abuse Treatment Standards.
- Skilled in using logic and reasoning to identify the strengths and weaknesses of alternative solutions, conclusions or approaches to problems, considering the relative costs. Skilled in the operations of a personal computer, including related software.
- Ability to tell when something is wrong or is likely to go wrong, and reaching conclusion to solve the problem.
- Skilled in complex problem solving the ability to identifying complex problems and reviewing related information to develop and evaluate options and implement solutions.
- Skilled in social perceptiveness of others reactions and understanding why they react as they do.
- Knowledge of principles and methods and procedures for promoting behavioral change regarding individual and community health.
