The White Earth Tribal Council is currently seeking a qualified candidate to be responsible for providing a variety of mental health services for individuals, families, and groups. They are required to be culturally responsive in the development of diagnostic assessments, treatment plans, identification of appropriate treatment methods, and utilization of a variety of applied psychotherapeutic techniques.

- Conduct client interviews and complete diagnostic assessments following all tribal, state and federal guidelines.
- Assist clients with understanding their problems and developing plans to resolve them.
- Provide individual, family and group psychotherapy through a variety of techniques, modalities and interventions.
- Collaborate/consult with and make referrals to cultural/traditional helpers and healers.
- Ensure all documentation is up to date and follows all tribal, federal and state related standards.
- Other duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

- Knowledge of principles, techniques and trends in counseling, psychotherapy, substance abuse and various treatment modalities.
- Knowledge of biological, behavioral and environmental aspects of emotional disturbances, mental health disability, and substance abuse.
- Knowledge of the scope and activities of tribal, public, and private health and child welfare agencies and other available community, tribal, country, state, and federal resources.
- Knowledge of the demographics, culture, customs and geography of the White Earth Reservation.
- Knowledge of federal laws including Health Insurance Portability Accountability Act (HIPAA), government regulations, federal privacy act and agency rules.
- Ability to facilitate meetings, staffing, in a culturally appropriate manner.

Qualifications:

- Master's degree in Psychology, Marriage & Family Therapy, Clinical Counseling, or Clinical Social Work, or a related field from an accredited college or university.
- Working towards a professional license to practice in one of the following fields: psychology, clinical social work, clinical counseling, or marriage and family therapy.
- Must be free of chemical or alcohol abuse problems for at least two years and have knowledge of traditional systems of healing.
