The White Earth Reservation Tribal Council is currently seeking a qualified applicant who will be responsible for patrolling assigned areas of the White Earth Reservation to enforce federal, state, local and tribal codes and statutes, regulate traffic, control crowds, prevent crime and arrest violators.

- Provides public safety by maintaining order to ensure community members are safe.
- Creates and completes reports to comply with the required laws.
- Communicates with internal and external sources to ensure the Public Safety department is represented in a professional manner.
- Respond to emergencies, protection people and property, enforcing motor vehicle and criminal laws and promoting good community relations.
- Arrest suspects and perpetrators of criminal acts.
- Patrol specific area on foot or motorized conveyance, responding promptly to calls for assistance.
- Performs other duties and responsibilities as required or assigned.

### Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of and ability to follow and apply the policies and procedures of the White Earth Tribal Council and the Public Safety Department.
- Skill in using personal computers and related software such as Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, Outlook), and internet.
- Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing with co-workers, staff and administration.
- Knowledge of laws, legal codes, court procedures, government regulations, executive orders, agency rules and the democratic political process.
- Ability to work cooperatively within a group to make the work of the group successful and effective.
- Skilled in giving full attention to what other people are saying, taking time to understand the points being made, asking questions as appropriate and not interrupting at inappropriate times.
- Ability to combine pieces of information to form general rules or conclusions, including finding a relationship among seemingly unrelated events.
- Knowledge of the White Earth Reservation demographics, culture, history, and lifestyles.

### Qualifications:

- **Associates degree in Law Enforcement or related field and graduate of an accredited police academy recognized by the Peace Officer Standards and Training Board (POST).**
- **Must have Full Time POST Board licensure or be eligible to be licensed.**
- **Must provide a copy of POST licensure or POST eligibility with application.**
- **Must be physically and mentally able to use force to fulfill job duties.**
- **Valid Driver's License and insurance for travel between sites and other related businesses.**
- **Must be able to pass a criminal background check and drug screening.**
