The White Earth Reservation Business Committee is currently seeking a qualified applicant who will be responsible for providing individual mental health rehabilitative services to clients with a serious mental health diagnoses, in the form of instruction, support, and skill coaching. The ARMHS mental health practitioner will provide culturally responsive mental health services in four areas: Basic Living and Social Skills, Community intervention, Medication Education and Transitioning to Community Living.

Positions outcomes:

- Provides basic living and social skills activities and case management that restore a client's ability to manage his/her illness or treatment and maintain independent living.
- Maintains all forms of documentation and reports to ensure records meet Providers and third-party billing requirements.
- Participates in individual and group supervision with Mental Health Professional to ensure effectiveness of services and gain insight for treatment.
- Performs other duties and responsibilities as required or assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of and ability to follow and apply the policies and procedures of the White Earth Reservation Business Committee, and the Mental Health department.
- Knowledge of the culture, customs and geography of the White Earth Reservation.
- Knowledge of tribal and county health and social services programs.

- Knowledge of principles and methods for teaching and instruction for individuals and groups, and the measurement of training effects.

Qualifications:
