The White Earth Reservation Tribal Council is currently seeking a qualified applicant who will be responsible for instructing students in an assigned subject area (literacy/reading) to ensure the mission of the school.

Position outcomes:

- Interpret data and provide support to classroom teachers to improve instruction.
- Evaluate each student's assessment data and record areas of strength and areas of needed growth.
- Work alongside teachers to develop specific plans based on data to support student learning.
- Support and nurture a team approach of instruction through co-teaching practices/coaching/collaboration with grade level teachers as part of COLA's inclusive teaching model.
- Performs other duties and responsibilities as required or assigned.
