The White Earth Tribal Council is currently seeking a qualified candidate to be responsible for providing a variety of mental health services for individuals, families, and groups. They are required to be culturally responsive in the development of diagnostic assessments, treatment plans, identification of appropriate treatment methods, and utilization of a variety of applied psychotherapeutic techniques.

Position Outcomes:

- Provide a variety of mental health counseling and psychotherapy techniques for clients and their families.
- Identify psychological, emotional or behavioral issues.
- Diagnose psychological, emotional or behavioral disorders.
- Meet with individuals, families, and groups in clinic, home, schools, and community settings to develop client centered service plans.
- Provide clinical direction for community based mental health program services such as CTSS and ARMHS.
- Other duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

- Knowledge of principles, techniques and trends in counseling, psychotherapy, substance abuse and various treatment modalities.
- Knowledge of biological, behavioral and environmental aspects of emotional disturbances, mental health disability, and substance abuse.
- Knowledge of the scope and activities of tribal, public, and private health and child welfare agencies and other available community, tribal, country, state, and federal resources.
- Ability to prepare treatment plans, client treatment recommendations, and a variety of reports.
- Ability to handle stress and unstable client behavior.
- Knowledge of the demographics, culture, customs and geography of the White Earth Reservation.
- Knowledge of federal laws including Health Insurance Portability Accountability Act (HIPAA), government regulations, federal privacy act and agency rules.

Qualifications:

- Two years of professional experience working in psychology, mental health counseling, psychotherapy, or related social services field.
- Master's degree in Psychology, Marriage & Family Therapy, Counseling, or Social Work, or a related field from an accredited college or university.
- Possession of a current license to practice in one of the following fields: psychology, clinical social work, clinical counseling, or marriage and family therapy.
- Must be free of chemical or alcohol abuse problems for at least two years and have knowledge of traditional systems of healing.
- Must be licensed or licensable by the White Earth Reservation Tribal Council.
- Must be able to pass a background check and drug screening.
