The White Earth Reservation Business Committee is seeking to provide Peer Support Specialist in the community to individuals and their families in recovery from a substance use disorder. The peer support services include education, advocacy, mentoring through self-disclosure of personal recovery experiences, attending recovery and other support groups with client, accompanying the client to appointments that support recover, assistance accessing resources to obtain housing, employment, education and advocacy series, and nonclinical recover support assist the transition from treatment into the recovery community.

- Implements peer support philosophies, interventions, and strategies.
- Provide Recovery support by mentoring, education, advocacy and not-clinical support.
- Provides Recovery Education to clients and family members to encourage family recovery.
- Promotes client's self-advocacy in recovery goal development and planning.
- Assists clients and family with community connections and access to community resources through case management, care coordination and community outreach.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of substance use disorder treatment philosophies and interventions including family recovery.
- Knowledge of principles, methods, and procedures for diagnoses treatment and rehabilitation for promoting behavioral change regarding individual, family and community health.
- Knowledge and ability to tell when something is wrong or is likely to go wrong, and reaching conclusions to solve problem
- Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing.

Qualifications:

- Requires a high school Diploma or GED.
- Must be over age 18, responsible, mature, healthy adult who is able to carry out the duties as assigned.
- Required to have a minimum of 6 months recovery from substance use disorder and must sign a statement attesting to that fact and freedom from chemical use problems must be maintained during employment.
- Obtain a minimum of 40 hours of documented training specific to the Peer Support.
- Submit at least (2) letters of recommendation and (2) reference letters confirming a minimum of six months of abstinence.
- Must pass criminal background check, must pass drug screen at hire and throughout employment according to White Earth HR policy.
- Must have a valid driver's license, be insurable by agency driver insurance, and have adequate vehicle insurance for travel between sites and other business-related destinations.
