The White Earth Reservation Tribal Council is currently seeking a qualified applicant for the Oshki Manidoo Program who will be responsible to prevent theft, violence, or infractions of rules to protect the White Earth Reservation Business Committee's property.

- Circulate among visitors, patrons, and employees to preserve order and protect property.
- Warn persons of rule infractions or violations, and apprehend or evict violators from premises, using force when necessary.
- Patrol industrial and commercial premises to prevent and detect signs of intrusion and ensure security of doors, windows and gates.
- Call police or fire departments in cases of emergency, such as fire or presence of unauthorized persons.

### Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of and ability to follow and apply the policies and procedures of the White Earth Tribal Council and the Public Safety department.
- Knowledge of relevant equipment, policies, procedures, and strategies to promote effective local, state, or national security operations for the protection of people, data, property and institutions.
- Knowledge of the structure and content of the English language including the meaning and spelling of words, rules of composition, and grammar.
- The ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing.
- The ability to tell when something is wrong or is likely to go wrong. It does not involve solving problem, only recognizing there is a problem.
- The ability to concentrate on a task over a period of time without being distracted.
- The ability to detect or tell the differences between sounds that vary in pitch and loudness.
