WHEREAS, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee received a request from the Leech Lake Band of Ojibwe to participate as amicus curiae in support of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA)'s denial of the U.S. Steel Corporation's application for a sulfate site-specific standard, and

WHEREAS, the White Earth Reservation Business Committee determined joining as amicus curiae in support of MPCA's denial continues to safeguard the treaty protected and culturally significant wild rice or Manoomin, now

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the White Earth Reservation Business Committee hereby approves the White Earth Band of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe joining as amicus curiae, and authorizes the White Earth Legal Department to take necessary actions in coordination with Leech Lake Band of Ojibwe, other amici, and/or their delegates to further this goal.
