 groups, self-care and independent living, social skills and hobbies and education. Mentor youth in educational,
 cultural, social, and physical activities.
- Document information, occurrences/incidents, treatment progress on a daily basis.
- Knowledge of youth chemical dependency treatment.
- Ability to consistently work shifts which include days, evening, overnights, and weekends.

Position Qualifications:

- High School diploma or GED.
- Experience in a residential setting or substance use treatment setting preferred.
- Must complete First Aid/CPR training within 3 months upon hire.
- Must be free of chemical use problems for at least one year immediately preceding their hiring and must sign a statement attesting to that fact and freedom from chemical use problems must be maintained during employment.
- Must be able to pass a criminal background check.
- Must pass a drug screen at hire and throughout employment according to White Earth HR policy.
- Prefer a valid MN driver's license, be insurable by agency driver insurance, and have adequate vehicle insurance for travel between sites and other business-related destinations.
