The Position is responsible for creating a classroom environment that fosters, promotes, and develops an understanding of the relationship between healthy body function and exercise; that motivates each student to cultivate physical fitness.

Outcomes:

- Works cooperatively with cultural education teachers in planning and implementing a balanced physical education program that incorporates the Anishinaabe culture.
- Develops lesson plans and supplementary materials compatible with the COLA's basic instructional philosophy and congruent with course and state standards; provides individualized and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of each student and subgroups of students.
- Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior to provide an orderly, productive environment in the physical education areas.
- Communicates with parents and school counselors on student progress.
- Evaluates academic and social growth of students, prepares report cards, and keeps appropriate records to include attendance reports, checklists, census forms, and other recordkeeping activities as necessary.
