Program Closures

Head Start: The White Earth Head Start Programs classrooms do not provide direct services to children on Fridays. All White Earth Head Start Programs services, including classrooms and home-based services, will be suspended beginning Monday, March 23 until April 3, 2019. An evaluation of the COVID-19 situation will be conducted prior to reopening any of the sites. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we evaluate and make decisions based upon life safety of our communities.

Child Care: The White Earth Child Care Center and the Mahnomen Child Care Center will remain open, providing services to children of essential and emergency personnel required to report to their respective work sites. The status of the child care centers will be evaluated on a daily basis.

Boys and Girls Clubs: The Boys and Girls Clubs of the White Earth Reservation will be open to children of working families through Friday, March 19, 2020. Beginning Monday, March 23rd, all Boys and Girls Clubs will be closed through April 3. An evaluation of the COVID-19 situation will be done prior to opening and of the BGC sites.

Elderly Nutrition Program: Beginning Monday, March 23rd, all Elderly Nutrition Program sites will be closed. All meals, including current home-bound meals, will be delivered.
