## **Educator Professional Development (May 1 and 4)**

This Friday (May 1) and Monday (May 4) are educator professional development days to prepare for the extension of distance learning through the end of our calendar school year. K-12 students do not have distance learning on these two days. We do not have to make up these student contact days.

- May 29 is the last day of K-12 distance learning.

### Deployment of K-12 Student Chromebooks and Jetpack Mobile Hotspots (May 4)

Next Monday (May 4), all K-12 students will receive their online distance learning technology. COLA will deploy Chromebooks and Jetpack Mobile Hotspots, to all K-12 students, via our Meals on Wheels bus routes. Students should be prepared to log-in to their Chromebooks on Tuesday (May 5) to connect virtually with their classroom teacher(s) and advisor(s).

- Our bus drivers will not drop off any online distance learning technology, without first making student or family eye contact.
- Students and parents should first direct troubleshooting questions with COLA online distance learning technology to their classroom teachers or advisors.
- In partnership with our WERBC Instructional Technology team, COLA took the time to individually
  program each student's Chromebook and Jetpack hotspot for the most optimal online start-up
